

Math Made Easy 1



How to Use miniLUK Controller:

1. Place miniLUK Controller alongside the workbook (not on top of the workbook).
2. Open miniLUK Controller case and place all 12 tiles with number-side facing up on top of the upper see-through lid. The black number 1 to 12 printed on the bottom half of the controller case will be the place to put the tiles based on the answers.

Example:

Please see Page 1 – “Count the objects”

1. Pick up tile **1**, and refer to exercise no. 1 on page 1.
2. Answer the question: “Count the objects” - Count how many apples here.
3. The answer is 5.
4. Place tile **1**, on top of the field 5 of the bottom half of the controller case.
5. Repeat the same step to finish all 12 exercises.
6. Close the controller case, flip it over so the back red side facing up, then open the red side again.
7. Compare the pattern to see if all questions were answered correctly.
